
About Dartmouth Journal Services

About eXtyles SI

- eXtyles SI is the Server Implementation of eXtyles.
- SI allows unattended batch processing of manuscripts.
- For each manuscript processed in SI, a manifest XML file that lists the processes to be run on a manuscript must be supplied.
- Manuscripts are run individually.





- Time savings (more on this in a moment)
- Workflow changes have freed up individuals for more productive work
- There are some articles that are not run through SI:
- Rush articles
- Short articles (for example, editorials or errata)
- Atypical articles (for example, reprints)

Benefit Analysis

How can you determine if SI will save you time?

Time savings is a function of:

- Manuscript length
- Number of tables and equations
- Size of AutoRedact
- Number of Advanced Processes

Lessons Learned

If you want to incorporate eXtyles SI you will need:

Scripting and network infrastructure expertise
 eXtyles SI is not ready to go out of the box.
 You have to script the pieces together.

- To manage workflow changes
 "Interrupted" workflow can be a hard adjustment.
 Help people rethink their approach to eXtyles use.
 Provide training!
- To expect support issues
